Guidelines and procedures

In terms of the school's general goals, the broad aim of West Park School is to meet the needs of all its pupils by providing educational programmes in a positive and equitable learning environment.

At West Park School:

- Children not experiencing successful outcomes are identified by staff through assessment and sensitive observation.
- Whenever possible, the reasons why children are not experiencing successful outcomes are investigated and identified by staff.
- Children are, where necessary, referred to appropriate advisors or agencies who may be able to help.
- Programmes are developed and implemented to meet individual needs, in consultation with appropriate personnel.
- Parents of children so identified are consulted prior to referral to outside agencies, and kept informed.
- Provision is made in the school budget to allow for the allocation of necessary resources.

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
